

The Nagaoka Festival Peace Celebration The Grand Folk Dance Parade Let's Enjoy Dancing with Friends from around the World! Everyone is welcome to join!

This is a joyous event in which participants in *yukata*, a summer cotton *kimono* outfit, enjoy dancing Nagaoka's traditional folk dances together on August 1 (Sat.) from 7:25 p.m. Every participant is welcome to join some practice sessions in July. These sessions will also be great opportunities for you to interact with other participants.

Re: Practice Sessions (① – ⑤ in the calendar)

- The size of your *yukata* (S, M, L, or LL) for August 1 (Sat.) and the time to put on your *yukata* will be confirmed in one of the sessions ① – ④. **All participants are requested to join dance practices at least twice including the full line-up practice.**
- When applying, choose which practice sessions you will join. If you want to change your practice dates after having applied, please contact the staff of the Nagaoka City International Affairs Center, *Chikyû Hiroba*.
- All participants are required to attend the full line-up practice on July 27 (Mon.), where you will dance in line just like the actual performance on August 1 (Sat.).

Things to Bring:

- Participation fee: ¥1,000
- Two rectangular face towels to be used when putting on a *yukata*
- Shoes to be worn when dancing
You are advised to wear shoes that you are used to and won't tire you out even if you walk a lot.
- Water or other beverages

Note:

- You can get help to put on your *yukata* from a volunteer dresser. Please reserve a time to put on your *yukata* during a practice session so that the dressing room will not be crowded.
- You are not allowed to eat in the Nagaoka Civic Center. You are advised to finish your dinner on your own before you come to the center.
