Vaccination Procedures

Vaccination Fee

Free

(Fully Covered by Public Funds)

1 Confirm when you are able to get vaccinated

COVID-19 vaccinations are scheduled to begin in the following order of priority:

- 1 Medical personnel
- 2 People born before April 2, 1957
- 3 People with underlying illnesses and people working at elderly-care facilities
- 4 People not in the above 1, 2, and 3 Note: The above vaccination order may be subject to change later.

Information about when you are able to get vaccinated will be provided via the Nagaoka City website, the City Newsletter, and information flyers. You can also call the Nagaoka City COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center at 0570-012-035.

2 Make Reservations at a Vaccination Site

Medical institutions or locations in Nagaoka City where vaccinations are available will be announced on the Nagaoka City website and in the City Newsletter as soon as they are determined.

- **Reservations are necessary for vaccinations.**
(Refer to the back page for how to make reservations for vaccinations.)
- In principle, you should be vaccinated in the municipality where you are registered as a citizen.

Note: For vaccinations in a location other than the municipality of your registered residence:

- Those who want to be vaccinated at a medical institution while hospitalized or staying in a certain facility
→ Consult with the medical institution or facility.
- Those who want to be vaccinated at a medical institution where they are receiving treatment for their underlying illnesses
→ Consult with the medical institution.
- Those living in a location other than their registered residence
→ You may be able to get vaccinated in the municipality where you are actually living. Consult with the respective municipality.

Note: Those who have moved out of Nagaoka City cannot use the coupons issued by the City of Nagaoka after having moved out. Consult with the municipality to which you have moved and request a coupon issued by that municipality.

3 Receive Vaccinations



Receive vaccinations at available medical institutions or other locations on the date you made reservations.

Things to Take to the Vaccination Site

- 1 The COVID-19 Vaccination Coupon (enclosed in this notice envelope)
- 2 Your ID (driver's license or health insurance card)
- 3 One sheet of the enclosed Medical Questionnaire Forms
(Fill in the form with the necessary information on the day of your vaccination and take it with you.)

Note:

- **On your vaccination day, take the coupon as is with you to the medical institution or location where you have made a reservation. DO NOT paste it on the medical questionnaire form or cut it out.**
- A lost or damaged coupon can be reissued. The procedure for reissuing coupons will be posted on the Nagaoka City website once it has been decided.
- Take your temperature on your vaccination day. If it is obvious that you have a fever or feel unwell, cancel your vaccination by calling the medical institution or the Nagaoka City COVID-19 Vaccination Call Center.
- **Wear clothes that can easily expose your shoulder, if possible.**
- You should get another shot of the same type of vaccine after a certain interval for it to be effective.
- The enclosed coupon has two parts. The first part consists of two tickets, one for each of the two vaccination shots and the other is two certificates of the completion of vaccination. You are advised to keep your certificate secure and do not lose it even after having been vaccinated.



Your Consent Is Necessary to Receive a Vaccination

You must determine on your own whether to get vaccinated or not by understanding the positive effects of the vaccination as well as the possible risks of side effects. Vaccinations will not be given without your consent.

If you are currently under treatment for certain illnesses or if you are worried about your health conditions, consult with your physician to determine whether to get vaccinated or not.

- 2 To get vaccinated at a location set up by the City of Nagaoka
