Coupons will be issued to people born between April 2, 1957 – June 28, 2009. People born after this date will be issued with a coupon in the order in which they reach their 12th birthday.

* Coupons will be drawn up on the basis of resident registration as of June 10, 2021.

* Publication contains information as of June 10, 2021 and may change.

How to get vaccinated

- To receive a vaccination **you must make a booking.**
- All people eligible for vaccination can be vaccinated **free of charge.**
- In principle, vaccination will be carried out in the city, town or village **where you have your certificate of residence.**
 - ※vaccination outside the area where you have your certificate of residence (address registered)
 - People in hospital or prison who will be vaccinated in primary care centers and in hospital or prison
 - ➔ Please consult with the primary care center and facility
 - People who will be vaccinated in the primary care center where they are receiving treatment for an underlying condition
 - ➔ Please consult with the primary care center.
 - People who don't live at their registered address
 - ➔ Please inquire at the city, ward, town or village where you actually live. You may be able to get vaccinated in your area.



People who have moved from Nagaoka City to another city, ward, town or village

Once you have moved you will not be able to use the coupon issued by Nagaoka City.

Please inquire at the city, ward, town or village where you have moved and ask for the coupon to be re-issued.



Medical personnel and others who have already been vaccinated

If you have already been vaccinated, please discard the coupon.

The COVID-19 vaccination is a two-shot vaccination. You cannot receive a third shot.

Please verify before booking

- People who have received another vaccination, such as **the combined measles-rubella vaccination**, in the previous two weeks cannot be vaccinated against COVID-19. **Please book a slot after two weeks have passed.**
- The Pfizer vaccine is for people of 12 and over and the Moderna vaccine for people of 18 and over. At Nagaoka City's Group Vaccination Centers we currently use the Pfizer vaccine. Later, the Moderna vaccine will be used at large vaccination centers set up by Niigata Prefecture.

Individual vaccination at medical institutions

As soon as we have reached a decision on which medical institutions will carry out individual vaccinations and on how to book, we will provide information on the City Newsletter and Nagaoka City Home Page.

*** Please refrain from calling individual medical institutions for the above information.**

Vaccination at group vaccination centers



Please verify the following before booking a vaccination.

- If you have an underlying health condition or allergies, discuss the vaccination with your primary care physician before your taking the vaccination.

1 Verify vaccination center and dates

- Vaccination Centers **Saiwai Plaza – Hive Nagaoka – Nagaoka Red Cross Hospital – Nagaoka Chuo Sogo (Central General) Hospital – Nakanoshima Community Center – Koshiji Gym – Mishima Kaikan Hall – Tochio Industrial Exchange Center, Orinasu**

* These are based on the current condition and are subject to change.

- Vaccination dates and start of bookings : as soon as a decision has been reached, information will be provided on the City Newsletter and Nagaoka City Home Page.

* You may choose a vaccination center in any area, not only the area where you live.

2 Booking

There are three ways to book. Choose one of the following.

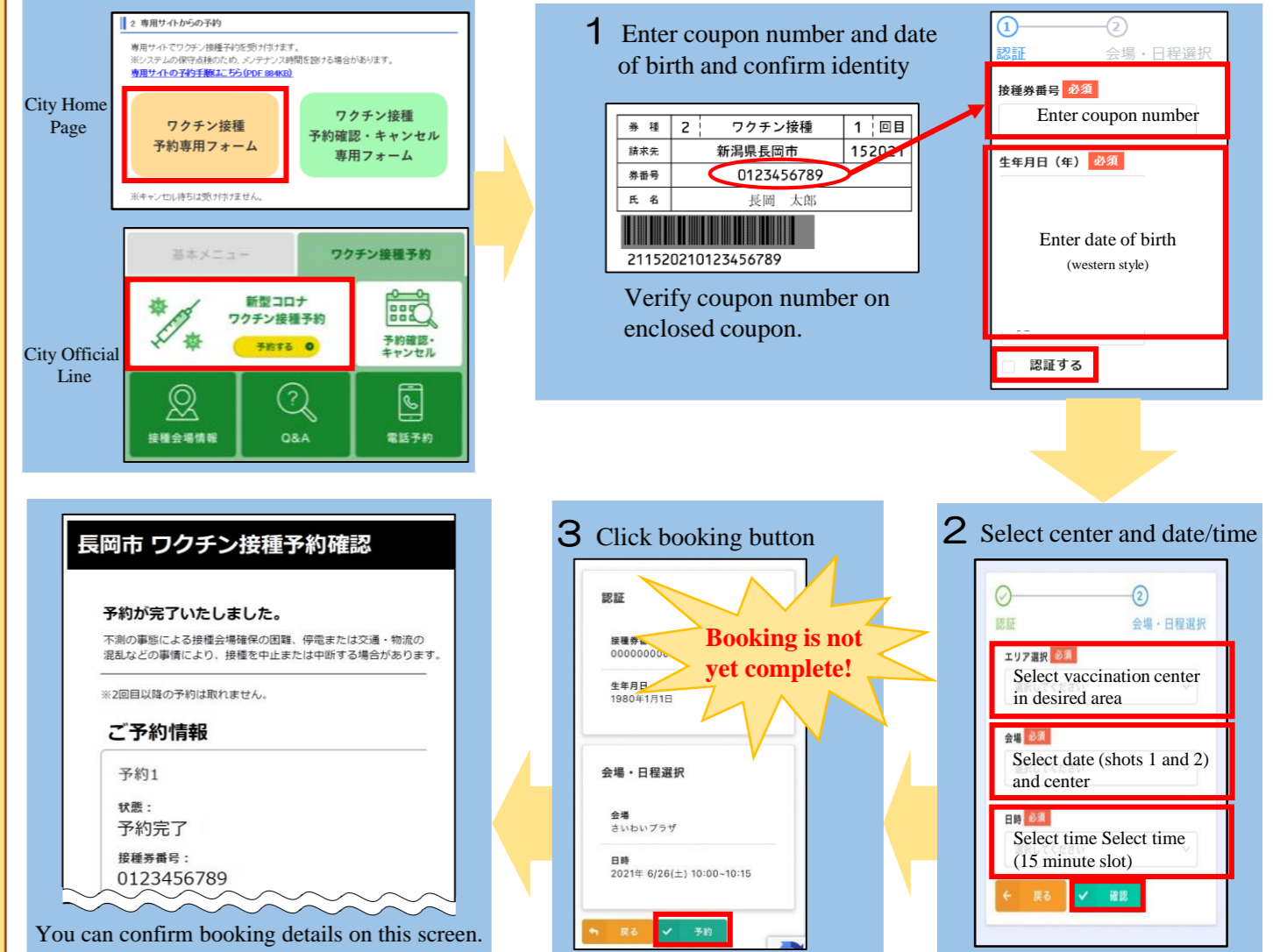
- To book you will need a coupon number (10 figures) and your date of birth (western style).
- One booking covers both appointments. When you book your first appointment you will automatically be assigned a second appointment three weeks later at the same center and the same time.
- Bookings are for 15 minute time slots. There is a fixed number of people in each time slot.

If you would like to change the date/time of your vaccination appointment or your vaccination center, **make sure to cancel the vaccination center you have already booked before making a new booking.**

3 Procedure on the very day of vaccination

① Check temperature and physical condition

If you have an obvious fever or if you aren't feeling well you shouldn't get vaccinated. Contact the city call center (0570-012-035).



Please don't come to the vaccination center in the following cases.

- You had a temperature of at least 37.5°C in the previous week
- Anybody who has contacted in the previous fortnight a person who is positive or suspected to be positive for the new coronavirus (including those living together or in the workplace)
- In the previous fortnight you left Niigata Prefecture, or a family member residing with you left Niigata Prefecture and returned with a cold or fever.

② Verify what you have brought

- COVID-19 vaccination coupon (bring with backing sheet and don't peel off the seal)
 - Personal verification documents (my number card, driving license, health insurance card, etc.)
 - One pre-examination slip (Two are enclosed in the vaccination coupon envelope. Complete the required items and bring one slip with you.)
- ※ Wear clothes which slip easily off your shoulders.

③ Arrive at the time you have booked

To avoid crowding, you can't enter the vaccination center even if you arrive early. Please arrive at the time you have booked, wearing a mask. Please keep companions to a minimum and don't talk in the vaccination center.

④ Pre-examination, vaccination and post-vaccination observation by physician

After vaccination, to make sure there are no changes in your physical condition, you will be kept under observation in the center for about 15 minutes. People who are worried about allergies will be kept under observation post-vaccination for about half an hour.
